



Get quick and easy access to the EJI

If you are a Chartered Psychologist or hold an MSc in Psychology, you may be eligible to use the EJI without undertaking further qualifications.

How do I know if I am eligible?

OPP offers open access to the Emotional Judgment Inventory to people with an academic or professional specialism in psychology. The specific criteria for eligibility are:

- A Master's degree in Psychology (or an equivalent) from a recognised university
- OR
- Official Chartership/license as an occupational psychologist (or equivalent) from a recognised body (eg the BPS)

AND

- Training in psychometrics as part of the degree course or Chartership.

I am eligible – how do I get access?

- If you meet the educational criteria set out above, you will be asked to provide evidence of your undergraduate and graduate degrees and/or your Chartership/license status.
- You will be required to purchase and read The Emotional Judgment Inventory Manual (eBook) so that you understand the properties of the EJI, its concepts, construction, scale meanings, normative basis and how it can be applied appropriately and professionally.
- OPP recommends that psychologists in Europe attend OPP's EJI webinar, as this will support their professional use of the tool. However, this training is not obligatory for those who meet the educational standards set out above.

I am not eligible for open access, but I still want to use the EJI

- If you are not a psychologist or MSc holder, you can still get access to the EJI by attending BPS-approved Test User Occupational, Personality (TUOP, formerly Level B) training provided by OPP in the UK. The European equivalent to the BPS TUOP qualification (EFPA's European test user's certificate) is also an accepted standard for access to the EJI.
